





We make a P.L.A.N. before we go places so that the grown up who is in charge knows where we are going and what we are doing. It's important to make a plan – and stick to it – to stay safe.

EACH STEP OF P.L.A.N. HELPS KEEP ME SAFE.

P – is important because I should always have **PERMISSION** from the grown up who is in charge before I go anywhere or do anything.

L – tells the grown up in charge the **LOCATION** where I will be. This is a very important step because if it changes, I must begin the P.L.A.N. process again.

A – tells the grown up who is in charge about the **ACTIVITY** I will engage in while I am gone.

N – is the NAME and PHONE NUMBER of the person(s) I am with.



 Decorate by coloring, adding glitter, and any other desired decorations






MAKE A SAFETY BAROMETER

Directions:


- Color one segment of the circle green, one segment of the circle yellow, and one segment of the circle red, as shown on the Safety Barometer card.

- Attach the arrow with the brad, inserting it through the hole in the arrow and the hole in the Safety Barometer.




IS IT SAFE?













Your mom is in the car pick up line waiting to pick you up from school. How do you feel about the situation? Why? What should you do?








You are home alone and want to go outside and play in your yard. There is a person that you don't know well sitting in a car outside your house. How do you feel about the situation? Why? What should you do?

MAKE A P.L.A.N.



P.L.A.N.						
P = PERMISSION	You should always ask for and receive permission before you go somewhere. If you want to go somewhere your parents won't agree to, then you probably shouldn't be there.					
L = LOCATION	Make sure your parents or another responsible adult knows where you are going. This means the exact location, not just a "friend's house." If there is an emergency, you need to know the address so you can get help.					
A = ACTIVITY	What are you going to be doing when you get to the location?					
N = NAMES & NUMBERS	Give your parent or responsible adult the names and phone numbers of the person or people you are going to be with.

You get to the Rec Center and the basketball courts are being sanded! **Do you ...**

After you meet up with Rodney and Rick, Rick decides to take the group to the movies instead. That sounds fun to you and Rodney. **Do you** ...

Head to the public basketball court down the street without telling mom – she'll be fine with it, you're sure!


Your mom gives Permission to go to the movie theatre location, but says no to the activity – the movie you picked was rated R! You agree to a different movie, and mom says to have fun.
